You will need to purchase a <u>total of two (2) Fleet Enemas, adult size,</u> at your local pharmacy or grocery. These are sold over-the-counter and are in a green and white box. Instructions for use are on the package.				
THE DAY PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE				
You may eat your regular lunch meal that day. <u>After lunch you may have clear liquids only</u> . (Clear liquids include coffee and tea without milk, apple, grape or cranberry juices, chicken or beef broth, Jell-O, etc.) DAIRY PRODUCTS IN ANY FORM ARE NOT CONSIDERED CLEAR LIQUIDS.				
Take your medication as usual unless otherwise instructed.				
EXAM DAY				
Continue the clear liquid diet this morning until after the procedure.				
Use the <u>first enema t</u>				
Use the second enema one (1) hour before the procedure. Time:				
NOTE: If your physician feels that you need to take antibiotics prior to this procedure for prophylactic measures, he will have given you a prescription to have filled to take prior to the procedure.
