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H Pylori Breath Test Instructions:

2 weeks prior to Breath Test:

Please discontinue all PPI Medication as this can give a false reading on the HPylori Breath Test. These medications include: Omeprazole, Prilosec OTC, Prevacid, Protonix, Aciphex, Dexilant, and Nexium. If you are taking any Pepto-Bismol or Pepto-Bismol type products or Carafate or Sucralfate these also must be discontinued.

You can not be on any antibiotics two weeks prior to the test.

(If you have not stopped these medications we will need to reschedule your breath test.)

If you are taking **Zantac**, **Tums**, **Maalox** or **Mylanta** – this is **OK**, you do not need to stop.

The day of the test:

You must fast one hour prior to your scheduled test.

You will go to the lab, breathe into one of the breath collection bags, and drink a solution of Pranactin-Citric. The solution will taste like lemonade without the sugar in it.

Please be advised that if you have or ever have had a reaction to Phenylalanine (one of the protein components of Aspartame) this solution does contain that protein.

You will be waiting 15minutes; and then you will breathe into the second breath collection bags.
