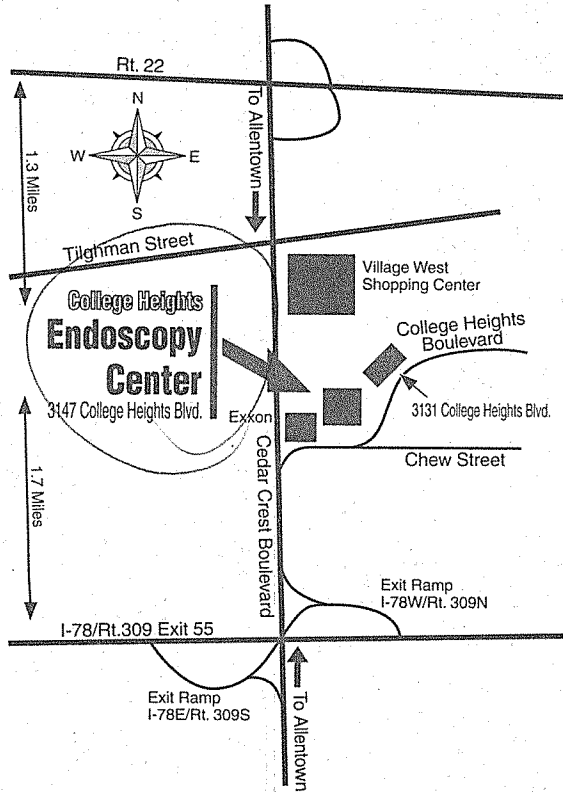


OUR LOCATION

We are conveniently located at 3147 College Heights Boulevard. The building is visible from the intersection of Cedar Crest Boulevard and Chew Street, one block south of the Village West Mall. The center is easily accessible from I-78, Route 309 and 22.



DIRECTIONS TO COLLEGE HEIGHTS ENDOSCOPY CENTER

From the N.E. extension of Pa. Turnpike:

- ⇨ Take route 22 East to Route 309 South (I-78 East).
- ⇨ Follow Route 309 South to Cedar Crest Blvd. Exit. Turn left from the exit.
- ⇨ Continue going straight on Cedar Crest Blvd. to Chew Street
- ⇨ Turn right at Chew Street
- ⇨ At the "Y", turn left onto College Heights Blvd. ED Turn left into parking lot to College Heights Endoscopy Center.

From Route 309 (I-78):

- ⇨ Take Cedar Crest Blvd. exit. If traveling north on Route 309 (I-78 West), turn right from exit. If traveling south on Route 309 (I-78 East), Turn left.
- ⇨ Continue on Cedar Crest Blvd. to Chew Street
- ⇨ Turn right at Chew Street.
- ⇨ At the "Y", turn left onto College Height Blvd.
- ⇨ Turn left into parking lot to College Heights Endoscopy Center.

From Route 22 East or West:

- ⇨ Take Cedar Crest Blvd. exit.
- ⇨ Turn left at the top of exit ramp.
- ⇨ Follow Cedar Crest Blvd. to light at Chew Street.
- ⇨ Turn left at Chew Street.
- ⇨ At the "Y", turn left onto College Heights Blvd.
- ⇨ Turn left into parking lot to College Heights Endoscopy Center.

PREPARATION FOR PROCEDURE

- Do not eat or drink anything, including water, after midnight the day before the procedure unless otherwise directed by your physician
- Your physician will review your medications and determine if any changes are needed for the day of the procedure.
- Leave all jewelry and valuables at home. All body piercings must be removed.
- Remove all nail polish, make-up and contact lenses before you come to the Center.
- Avoid perfumes and body lotions.
- Wear casual, loose clothing. During the procedure, you will wear a patient gown provided by the Center.
- Please bring all insurance cards, picture ID, and living will (if applicable) with you on day of procedure.

DISCHARGE FROM THE CENTER

- Arrange for transportation to and from College Heights Endoscopy Center. You will not be allowed to drive after your procedure due to the sedation given. Your driver is allowed to leave once you have checked in, however, a name and phone number where they can be reached must be provided. They will be given a time to return in order to be present for discharge instructions.
- You may not take the bus or a taxi home.
- When you arrive home wait at least 12 hours before you:
 - Resume normal activities
 - Drive or operate any equipment
 - Drink alcoholic beverages
- You will receive other instructions at the time of your discharge.
