RAL INSTRUCTIONS:
This procedure will be performed at the Gastrointestinal Diagnostic Center (GIDC), 700 Geipe Suite 220. A colonoscopy takes approximately 20-30 minutes. You will then be taken to the y room, where you will remain approximately 1 hour.
You will be sedated for this procedure and will not be allowed to drive home or return to work after sedure. Please arrange for a responsible adult to transport you to and from the center. PROCEDURE WILL BE CANCELLED IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A RESPONSIBLE ADULT WITH
ATIONS:
If you are taking iron medications discontinue 10 days prior to preparation. If you are taking aspirin, or aspirin containing medications, discontinue 7 days prior to preparation. Arthritic medications should be discontinued 4 days prior to preparation. If you are taking Metamucil, Colace, Pericolace, or a similar product, discontinue 2 days prior to preparation. If you are Diabetic , please discuss your medication with your physician. Take ½ dose of the day before your procedure,
and none the morning of your procedure. If you are taking antibiotics, you may continue as instructed. Coumadin or other blood thinners may be stopped for several days prior to the procedure. Please discuss this with your physician. Do not take any tranquilizers on the morning of your procedure, because you will have sedation. If you are taking medication for your heart, you may take your medication with 4 oz. of water the morning of your procedure. If you are taking medication for high blood pressure, please discuss this with your physician. Please notify your physician if you are unable to complete your preparation for this procedure.
